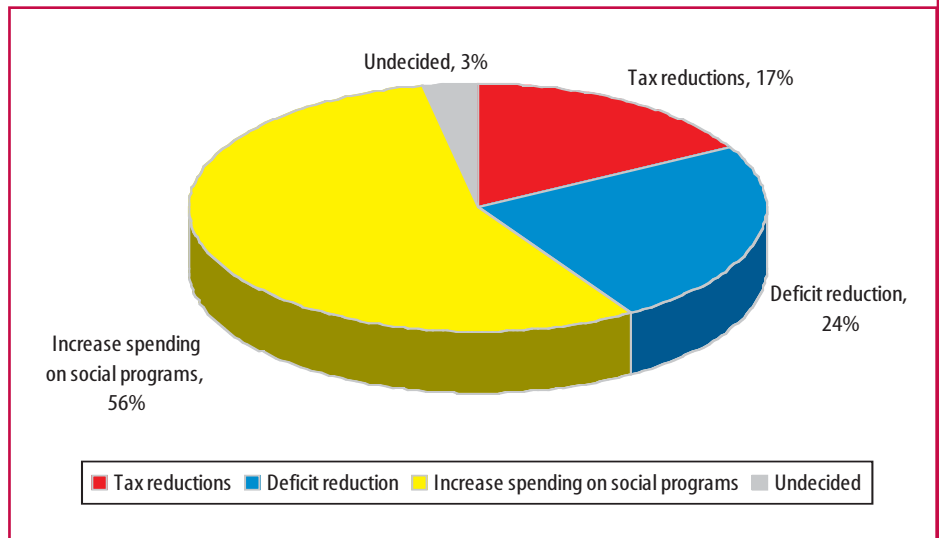
SES Ontario Omnibus Survey

Between May 24 and May 26, 2005, SES Research conducted a random telephone survey of 500 Ontarians 18 years and older.

The accuracy of a random survey of 500 Ontarians is $\pm 4.4\%$, 19 times out of 20. The initiative was part of the SES Ontario Omnibus Survey and was registered with the Marketing Research and Intelligence Association of which SES is a member.

Results may not add up to 100% due to rounding.

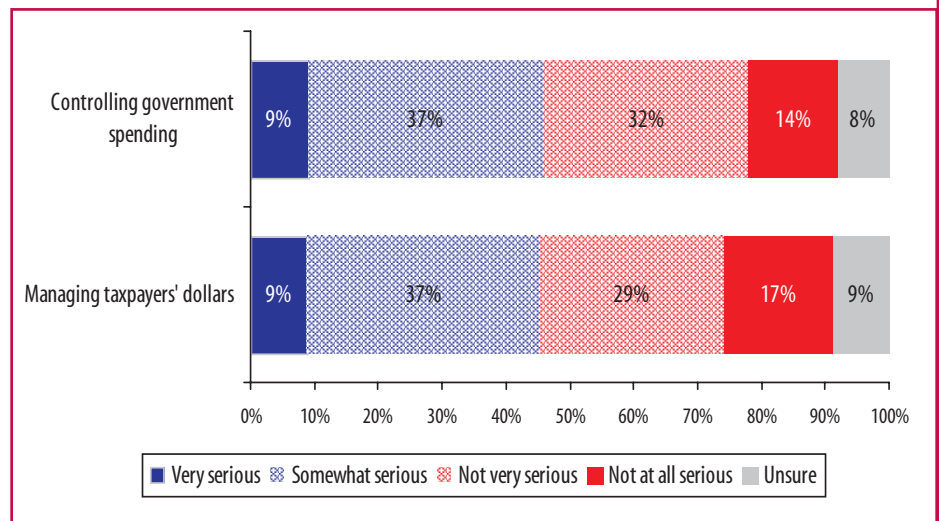

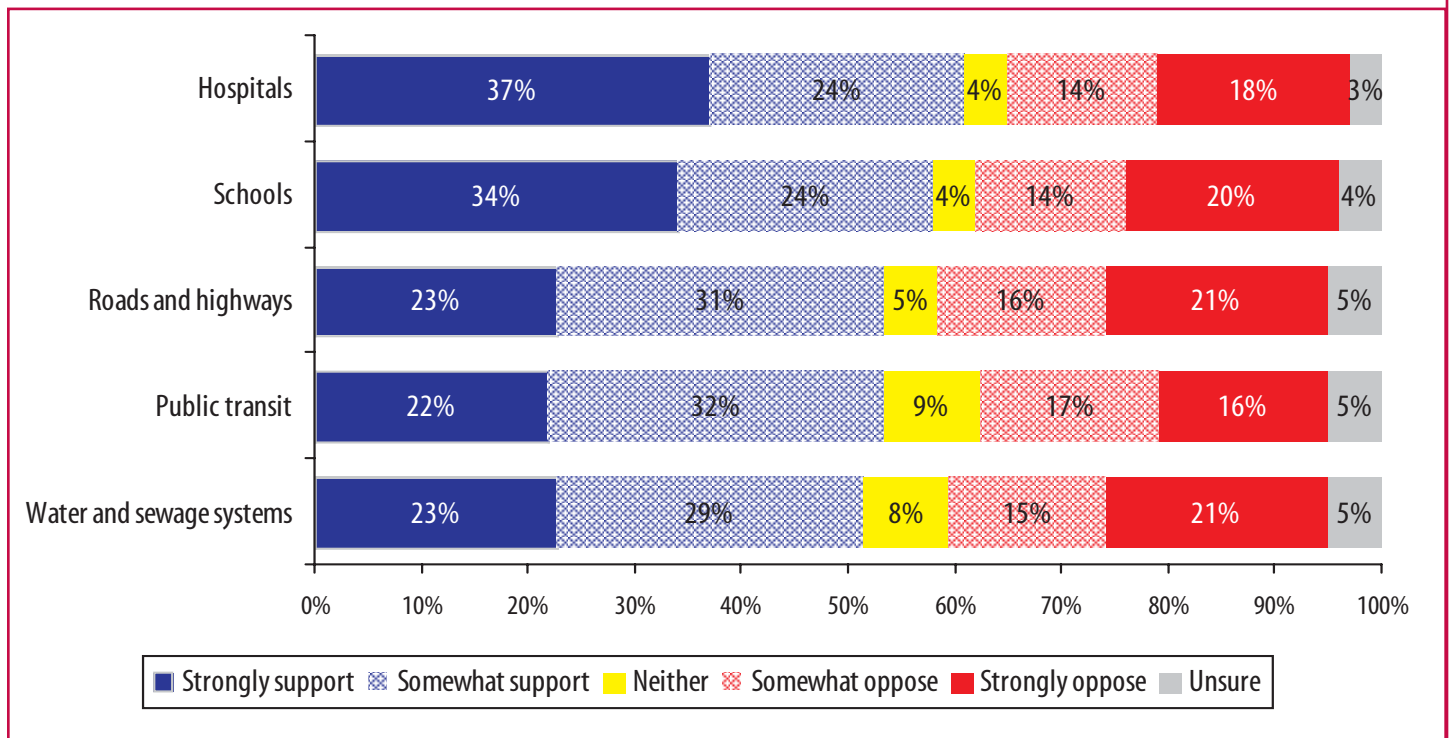
